BOARD RECOGNITION POLICY

## THE PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY IS TO:

Establish an equitable system of recognizing the volunteer involvement of Council - appointed community representatives to the various Boards and Commissions of the City of Drumheller.

## POLICY STATEMENT:

The Council of the City of Drumheller shall maintain a Volunteer Recognition Program for those citizens who are appointed by Council to Boards, Commissions and Committees of the City.

## PROCEDURES:

- The office of the City Clerk shall maintain a current list
  of all Council-appointed board members, their addresses, and
  board terms.
- City Council shall annually host a recognition event for all members of Council-appointed boards, commissions and committees. This shall be co-ordinated by Family and Community Support Services.
- 3. City Council shall award a recognition plaque to all eligible volunteer appointees on their retirement from their position. A minimum of one year's involvement with a board, commission or committee is required. In cases of volunteers who hold less than one year's involvement, a letter shall be presented on behalf of City Council.
  - 4. It shall be the responsibility of the appropriate Department or Program Head to ensure that the appropriate recognition is provided and current names and addressess are maintained.
