



#### Q2 Do you have children under the age of 18 in your care?





#### Q5 Do you expect to be residing in Drumheller for the next five (5) years?





### Q7 Where is your first choice location to access programs, services and resources?







# Q49 How familiar are you with Drumheller Valley Family & Community Support Services (FCSS)?



### Q50 Please select the supports, resources and services that are most important to you in Drumheller. (Select up to 5).







### Q75 What is your estimated annual household income?






