RE: SANITARY SEWER DRAINAGE LINE CROSSING OUR UNDERGROUND POWERLINES IN PLAN 8966 EJ, PART OF NE-11-29-20-W4M

ATCO Electric Ltd. (Grantor) has no objections to **TOWN OF DRUMHELLER** (Grantee) commencing activity on the above mentioned proposal as shown on the attached sketch, **PROVIDING** that the Grantee will:

- 1. The Grantee is responsible for obtaining the appropriate rights and consent from landowners. In no way does this consent allow the Grantee access to the mentioned land(s) without first obtaining such rights and consents.
- Position of Facility, Grantor's Facility shall be entitled to the upper position in the Crossing Area except for above grade facilities. A minimum distance of 1 metre shall be maintained between the external surfaces of the underground Facilities; and Grantee's Facility shall be maintained at the same depth with no side bends for the entire width of the Crossing Area. SEE ATTACHED EMAIL FOR ATCO APPROVED CHANGE OF DISTANCE
- 3. Comply in all respects with Alberta Environment and Parks if applicable, and the provisions of the Occupational Health and Safety Act also Alberta Electrical Utility Code (AEUC) Safety Codes Act.
- 4. The Grantee must contact the Grantor's field representative TYLER SHARPE OF OUR DRUMHELLER OF DISTRICT OFFICE AT 403-823-1437 OR CELL 403-820-1421 (between 8am and 4pm excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Statutory Holidays) at least 72 hours prior to carrying out any construction under or near the Grantor's facilities to ensure that no safety hazards exist during construction and will comply with any additional terms or conditions requested by the Grantor's field representative.

- 5. The Grantee agrees that it will install the Grantee's Facilities where indicated on the Plan, provided that:
 - a) if the Grantee undertakes any ground disturbance and excavation of any kind within one (1) metre of the Powerline, the Grantee shall hand expose such disturbance and excavation under the direct supervision of the Grantor's field representative ("Grantor's Representative");
 - b) the Grantee will, at it's sole cost and expense, clearly mark the Grantee's Facilities with permanent visible markings to the satisfaction of the Grantor.
- 6. Since the Grantee facilities are to be located in the vicinity of the Grantor's powerlines, such pipeline will be subject to INDUCED VOLTAGES AND CURRENTS and these induced voltages and currents are potentially hazardous to persons and property when operating and maintaining the Grantee's Facilities. The Grantee

hereby assumes and accepts all risks associated with induced voltages and currents including the risk of property damage, personal injury and death ("Induction Risk.)" The Grantee is responsible, at its sole cost and expense, for undertaking all actions required to mitigate any such Induction Risk.

- 7. If encroaching on our right of way with an access road, the Grantor may use the road and the Grantee or its assigns shall not charge the Grantor or its assigns for use of the road.
- 8. Ensure that trees, dirt piles, logs, equipment or other debris are not left on Grantor's right of way including the common land. That upon completion of construction, passage on Grantor's right or way shall not be obstructed in any manner.
- 9. Should relocation or any alteration of the powerline be necessary, the Grantor agrees to raise, relocate or alter the powerline to accommodate the Grantee's facilities (road, pipeline etc.) The Grantee will bear all costs associated with raising or relocation. The Grantee must contact the above-mentioned field representative to arrange for the approval, construction schedule and payment of any costs incurred by the Grantor for any relocation.

10. Liability

Grantee shall be liable to Grantor for all loss, damages and expenses which Grantor may suffer, sustain, pay or incur by reason of any matter or thing arising out of or attributable to any act or omission of the Grantee, its servants, agents, contractors or employees in respect of the Grantee's use of the crossing area or by reason of this Agreement.

Indemnity

Grantee shall indemnify and save harmless the Grantor against all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, and costs which may be brought against or suffered by Grantor or which it may sustain, pay or incur, by reason of any matter or thing arising out of or attributable to any act or omission of Grantee, its servants, agents, contractors or employees in respect of Grantee's use of the crossing area or by reason of this Agreement.

Grantor shall indemnify and save harmless the Grantee against all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, and costs which may be brought against or suffered by Grantee or which it may sustain, pay or incur, by reason of any matter or thing arising out of or attributable to any act or omission of Grantor, its servants, agents, contractors or employees in respect of Grantor's use of the crossing area or by reason of this Agreement.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this agreement, the parties shall in no event be responsible or held liable for consequential damages, including without limitation, liability for loss of use of existing property, loss of profits, loss of product or business interruption however the same may be caused.

11. Ensure that the Grantee's clearing and/or construction contractors and equipment operators have a copy of this consent at the crossing area and are made aware of these conditions. Grantee must contact the above-mentioned field representative prior to and immediately after your work has been completed.

It is essential that the above conditions be adhered to at all times.

<u>Please signify your approval and acceptance of this agreement by having one (1) copy of this letter signed and returned to us as soon as possible.</u>

This agreement will terminate after two years of the date written above if construction has not occurred within that time.

Thank you for the quick turnaround on this crossing agreement request. There are a few details we would like to update prior to executing.

- 1. Please update the Grantee to be the "Town of Drumheller" instead of SweetTech Engineering Consultants.
- 2. Condition #2 within the letter currently states that a 1 m minimum separation distance between the external surfaces of underground utilities is required. SweetTech, in discussions with ATCO Electric engineering staff, identified this separation distance is not possible. SweetTech and ATCO looked at each crossing conflict and determined whether mitigation measures for each ATCO crossing were required. It was determined that the minimum allowable separation distance without mitigation measures for this project would be 0.3 m, and where this was not achievable, a 1 m x 1 m x 50 mm thick mechanical separation concrete pad was agreed upon as a mitigation measure.

The mitigation measures and separation distances are provided in the following table, which is also available on Drawing C-100 attached to our initial submission.

To Whom it May Concern:

SweetTech Engineering Consultants (SweetTech), on behalf of the Town of Drumheller, is requesting a crossing agreement to support the proposed Spray Park Drainage Line Improvement Project, in Drumheller, near the Aquaplex, primarily within an existing ATCO lease. The proposed work for this project involves the installation of a shallow sanitary sewer drainage line to reroute the spray park drainage to the existing Town of Drumheller sanitary sewer system.

The proposed project is located within PLAN 8966 EJ, PART OF NE-11-29-20-W4, on the west side of 1 Street W and south of the Drumheller Aquaplex. Specifically, work at this location is anticipated to include excavation and abandonment-in-place of two existing stormwater outfall lines, as well as the excavation and installation of a shallow sanitary sewer line and manhole between two existing manholes in the Rotary Spray Park and in 1 Street W respectively. It is anticipated that the work will be carried out with a small hydraulic excavator or backhoe, while hydrovac and manual excavation would be used within close proximity to underground utilities. Proposed crossings including crossings with existing ATCO Electric underground utilities are shown in the attached drawings.

The proposed construction is planned to commence in September 2023. It is anticipated that the work will take approximately 4-6 weeks to complete.

Development of this proposed project included review and input from ATCO Electric staff, including Shahedul Amin and Jason Pentland. Based on these reviews, consideration for mechanical separation at a crossing with low separation between existing and proposed utilities has been provided. Additionally, consideration for in-situ and imported soil contamination has also been given for this project.


